### What is ASEAP?

**ASEAP is an employer sponsored 4-year apprenticeship program for software field.**

#### Years 1 and 2:

**Curriculum** - Front-load 4-year college level “core” software engineering courses into the first 2 years of education thru a local community college.

**Earn while you learn** – While studying, work 20 hrs /week for the sponsoring employer.

#### Years 3 and 4:

**Full time employment** with the sponsoring employer in the software field.
